OFFICE ORDER

The Hawker License as per Paradip Port (Issue of License to Hawkers) order, 2010 was being issued to the following categories of service providers in respect of ancillary services to the ships and cargo.

- a. Authorised used / Waste oil receiver.
- b. Ship Chandling.
- c. Buying of Condemned materials.
- d. Marine Survey.
- e. Cargo Quality Survey.
- f. Ship repairing.
- g. To carry out Testing, Examination and Certification for Lifting appliances.
- h. Supply of life saving appliances & Fire Fighting equipments.

2. Pursuant to the decision of the Board of Trustees vide Resolution No. 56/2016-17 in their meeting held on 29.11.2016 and based on the recommendation of the committee, the competent authority has been pleased to de-license under 'Ease of Doing Business Initiative' the following 5 (five) categories of service providers from the Paradip Port (Issue of License to Hawkers) order, 2010:

- (i) Marine Survey
- (ii) Cargo Quality Survey.
- (i) Ship repairing.
- (ii) To carry out Testing, Examination and Certification for Lifting appliances.
- (iii) Supply of life saving appliances & Fire Fighting equipments.

The said 5 (five) categories of service providers will now be allowed to carry out their services on recommendation of concerned users, i.e. Steamer Agents, Importers, Exporters etc.. Harbour Entry Permits (HEP) will be issued to these 5 (five) service providers based on the volume and nature of work and port will facilitate to issue such HEP round the clock.

3. The Annual Harbour Entry Permit (HEP) in respect of the remaining 3 (three) categories of service providers viz. (Authorized Used/Waste Oil Receiver, Ship Chandling and Buying of Condemned Materials) may be issued only to the proprietor and temporary HEP for their workmen who will be issued license as per Paradip Port (Issue of License to Hawkers) order, 2010.
